Game Limits and Duration

55 minutes. If the time becomes an issue do not start new inning.

Playing Rules

- No umpires – no official score keeping; Suggestion- most outs “wins.” Coaches monitor the games. Teach Fundamentals.
- Three (3) defensive coaches will be allowed to assist the player in the field.
- The pitcher must stay on the pitching mound until the batter hits the ball.
- The coach must place the tee on home plate for the batter and remove the tee after ball is hit.
- Every player must play an infield position during each game.
- All players will play every inning; One player per infield position, all other players are in outfield;
- Batter is granted five (5) swings to hit the ball. If batter fails to hit the ball fair, then batter is ruled out.
- No bunting. A batter must take a full swing.
- All players will bat each inning.
- The pitcher is not allowed to make an unassisted out at first.
- Players cannot intentionally roll the baseball when making a play. The ball must be thrown to the defensive player.
- No infield fly rule.
- No stealing or leading off base. Runners must maintain contact with the base until the ball is hit.
- Bats must say TEEBALL on them.
- Batters may advance one base only. Exceptions: (1.) If the batter hits the ball to the outfield via a pop fly, the batter may advance two bases. (2.) If the batter hits a fair ball that hits the fence, the batter is awarded all four (4) bases (Homerun).
- The pitcher and catcher will wear a safety helmet with face mask while playing a game or at practice. Helmets will be furnished by the league. This is a safety issue that will be strongly enforced

All coaches and team moms will have to have undergone a background check by the safety officer to be able to be on the field at any time during the games.
